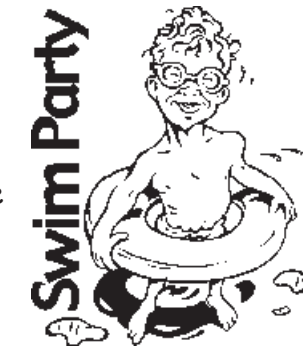

We live in complicated times! I don't think I know anyone who is craving for MORE decisions to be made, or MORE bills to be paid, or MORE people asking MORE of them.

Like most people, I suppose, I come to life...and I come to worship...with many things competing for my time and my mental and emotional energy.

That seems to be the nature of life in 2010.

However, it is becoming increasingly obvious that we live in a world of finite resources...not only physical resources and mineral resources...but also money and energy and mental drive and hours in the day.

The typical and predictable busy-ness of everyday life has for many people become a treadmill which drives us.

We have become George Jetson, and we find ourselves also saying, "Jane, how do you stop this crazy thing?"

My question to you is simply: how do we give each other permission to take the time it takes to get off the treadmill, to center ourselves and to focus...focus on our loved ones, focus on our purpose for life, focus on Jesus Himself? How do we stop this crazy thing?

When five of us on staff attended the Large Church Initiative in San Antonio in April, one of the notes I came back with was this quote from a speaker there:

"Don't attempt to do EVERYTHING, attempt to do the RIGHT THING."

To put it another and perhaps a stronger way: 'serving Jesus' is what life is all about; 'wearing ourselves out for Jesus' is counterproductive.

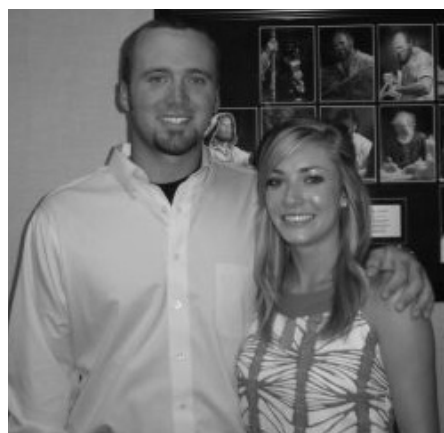
One place to start, perhaps, might be 'Radical Hospitality'.
