FROM THE PASTOR Touching the Future...
Touching the World

As you know, next week, June 14-18, is Vacation Bible School. Vacation Bible School will be a first priority for our brand-new Director of Children's Ministries, Kim Hopson, who began on our staff at the beginning of this week!

VBS holds wonderful memories for me when I was growing up in Iowa and I have great memories of our own girls' VBS experiences during their young years.

Vacation Bible School is a GREAT object lesson for us as to WHY we do church.

Let me ask you: why do we hold Vacation Bible School? Why do we go to all the expense and preparation?

Let me give you several possible and reasonable justifications for holding Vacation Bible School:

1. It gives our children and grandchildren a week of wholesome activity during the hot summer.
2. It is a vehicle to pass on to our children and grandchildren the basic tenets of our Christian faith.
3. It is a means by which we can reach beyond the walls of our church to impact the lives of the children and grandchildren of our neighbors and so change the world for Christ.

How many vote for answer number 1? How many vote for answer number 2? How many vote for answer number 3?

Guess what? ALL of the answers are correct. But here's the catch: while answer number 1 is correct, it is incomplete. We could prepare for and conduct a wide range of wholesome activities to fill up a summer's week.

How about answer number 2? Number 2 is better...and it touches beliefs which are important to us...but it is still not complete enough. What does it do for the children who DON'T belong directly to us?

Well, then, answer number 3? Bingo! Number 3 is the BEST answer. It is the COMPLETEST answer. It is what we are here for: to change our world for Jesus Christ. If we can hold "Number 3" answers in our hearts to EVERYTHING we do as a congregation, we can really make an impact in Canyon, Texas and beyond.
